Who is Kidventure?

Kidventure Camps, Inc. has been running quality summer day camps and overnight programs for the past 22 years throughout Texas. Last year, Kidventure Camps served over 10,000 children in the Houston, Austin and Dallas areas. Our first rate camps, our commitment to excellence and our genuine care for children and families have made us the premier choice for Houston families. Our all adult counselors and staff, comprised of teachers and students, have made us a hit with so many children and parents. Our goal is to lead children toward a happy, healthy and responsible lifestyle through successes in their activities with us.

What is Kidventure's After School Program?

Kidventure Camps, Inc. has provided after school programs for over 14 years! Patterned after our summer camp program, the Finale After School Program will provide a safe, wholesome, and fun environment during the school year. Curriculum will include homework time, arts and crafts, science, as well as, indoor/outdoor games. Please see information below on our newest addition to the Finale After School Family.

Finale Hours: Monday-Friday 3:40PM-6PM/Wednesday 2:40PM-6PM (Please see school schedule for half day dismissal and no school days, we will not run Finale on these days)

ENCORE CLUBS! We are excited to bring Encore Clubs to Finale. We believe this will be an added benefit for the children and families of the school. Encore will consist of two clubs for the 2016-2017 school year that will run during after school. Encore will run on various days through out the week between the hours of 4pm-6pm. Encore for Early childhood and 1st-8th grade will be held at different times. Please see registration form for more specific rates and times. Please note if a child is only registered for the Encore Clubs that the non-finale Encore rate will include care for that specific day.

You will have 3 participation options for the after school program in 2016-2017. Please see registration form for more specific and detailed information.

1. Participation in the Finale After School Program ONLY and NO Encore Club
2. Participation in the Finale After School Program AND Encore Club(s)
3. Participation ONLY in Encore Club(s) and NO Finale After School

How Do I Sign Up?

To sign up for Finale After School please go to kidventure.com. If these forms are not turned in your child will be unable to attend the after school program until all necessary forms are turned in. Upon registering you must certify that your child attends St. Theresa Catholic School and that his/her immunization record are on file at the school and all required immunizations and/or tuberculosis tests are current. Vision and learning screenings are also on file.



How Do I Pay?

Billing for Finale After School and Encore will be done through Kidventure. You may visit our website, kidventure.com that explains all billing and cost information and to register your child(ren) for Finale After School or Encore. Parents will be notified as soon as possible via email and Remind of any policy changes.

Refund & Billing Policies

Semester

For each semester rate selected a \$100 deposit is required with the remaining balance due in full by August 15th (fall) & December 15th (spring). If switching from the semester rate to another option you will be responsible for the full monthly rate (\$280) for each month attended.

Monthly

The remaining balance for each pre-registered month (\$10 deposit) will be automatically charged with the credit or debit card on file on the 25th of the previous month (or next business day if the 25th falls on a weekend). If you participate in a Finale session that you are not registered for, the credit card on file will be billed for your usage of the program. Failure to pay or make alternate arrangements with our office will result in your student not being allowed in to the Kidventure After School program until payment has been received.

Daily

Daily usage will be tracked and will be automatically charged the week following use. It is encouraged to purchase your first day in advance. If you participate in a Finale session that you are not registered for, the credit card on file will be billed for your usage of the program. Failure to pay or make alternate arrangements with our office will result in your student not being allowed in to the Kidventure After School program until payment has been received.

Refunds, transfers & payment plans of sessions may be granted on a case-by-case basis pending a written approval of the Kidventure office and the parent. Prorated rates are not available for Finale sessions.

Encore After School

A \$25 deposit is required for all Encore Clubs at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be auto-billed on the Wednesday following the first week of each specific Encore Club. Payments are non-refundable after billing has been processed for an Encore Club. Prorated rates are not available for any Encore Club. If the Encore Club is cancelled for any reason, a full refund will be issued. To receive the discounted rate on Encore tuition, children must be enrolled in the Finale program at the monthly rate for the entire semester.

Cancellation Requests for All Kidventure Programs

Cancellation requests must be submitted to our office in writing, either via email or fax.



Location and Activities For Children During Finale?

Once carpool is complete, all children will be dismissed to the Finale After School Program. Children that do not have a completed registration form on file will be unable to participate in Finale and/or Encore and a parent will be notified to come pick up their child.

Once all children registered for the Finale After School Program and Finale Encore are signed in they will participate in a variety of monthly themed activities including homework, art, science, athletics and games. We will utilize areas such as the field, classrooms, gym and Community Center. Children will be separated age appropriately and divided into separate areas. Children will be utilizing St. Theresa's playground/outdoor equipment, which may not meet minimum standards.

These activities will include:

Art, Science, Homework, Indoor/Outdoor Group Games, Daily Snack*.

Early Childhood will follow their own schedule and be separated from the 1st-8th grade children. 1st-8th graders will be split into age appropriate groups throughout the afternoon and follow their own schedules.

Children who are ONLY registered and paid in full for the Encore Club Program will be dismissed to Finale on Encore specific days and have a snack prior to participation in the specific club.

Medication

If your child will be taking medications of any kind during the Finale After School Program, a Medical Dosage Form must be filled out. This form must be turned into the Lead Counselor on site with the medication in its original container before medication will be dispensed.

All medications will be dispensed by the Lead Counselor as per your instructions. This includes over the counter medications such as Tylenol and Benadryl. Medical Dosage Forms will be made available upon request.

Sick Child at Finale After School

From time to time, children may become ill or do not feel well. At Finale we have a designated First Aid/ Sick Station, where he or she will be isolated from the other children and allowed to rest. If your child is sick, we will notify you and in some cases we will ask you to pick up your child.

Picking Up Your Child

Pick up for all programs (Finale and Finale Encore) will take place at the back gate off of Haskell. A family number will be given to those individuals designated on the after school registration form and will need to use this number to electronically sign out their child(ren) using the Kid Kiosk system. Please be prepared to show ID to ensure the safe release of all children.

Finale After School and Finale Encore will run until 6pm each day we are in session. Encore will run until 5pm on specific days.

Please note: Any child in attendance after 6pm will be charged a \$1/minute fee per child. This fee will be paid directly to the staff that stayed with that child. Habitual lateness may result in an increase in the \$1.00/min/child late fee payment and/or expulsion from the After School Program.



Discipline and Conduct

We understand that children are tired after a long day of school, but the same courtesy and respect practiced throughout the day should remain consistent in the After School Program. Kidventure's disciplinary action is a three-strike system, which is age appropriate.

1. Warning
2. Consequence (Time out-1 minute per age, sentences, sit out of activity)
3. Call Home

We work closely with St. Theresa and the principle on needed discipline and conduct issues.

Parent Visitation

Parents are welcome to visit the Finale After School Program at any time during normal hours without prior notice or approval to observe their child, observe the operation and/or program activities.

What are the Qualifications of the Finale After School Staff?

The most important part of your child's after school experience is their staff. Kidventure prides itself on selecting experienced, active and caring individuals for its programs. All counselors are First Aid and CPR trained, Virtus (sexual abuse prevention) certified, and wears the Finale uniform. In addition to our counselors that are counted in ratio (1:10 for 1st-8th grade and 1:8 for Early Childhood) we have a lead counselor that maintains day-to-day operations on site. We also have an After School Program Coordinator that is responsible for creating the program curriculum, ensuring that all supplies are on site and ultimately responsible for the successful operation of Finale After School Program. Counselor's must be free from Tuberculosis but are not required to be vaccinated. Our staff is committed to your children and encourages you to offer your comments and suggestions.

Who Are Our Encore Club Vendors?

Please note that Encore instructors will never be left alone with children. Encore instructors will lead the weekly classes and our Finale After School staff will be there to assist in any way necessary. All Encore information is available online at our website: kidventure.com.

How Do I Contact the After School Staff?

You may call the Kidventure Finale After School Program Director Ryan Isbrecht at 817.829.6185 who then can relay any needed information to the after school staff.

Monthly Communications

All major communication will come through the Kid Kiosk system via email or text. Please make sure all contact information is up to date. A monthly newsletter will be emailed providing updates and notes of what activities are happening.

Emergency Procedures

In the event of severe weather or any other potentially threatening situations, Finale will make every effort to notify you immediately regarding your child's safety. Please make sure all contact information is correct and up to date. If cancellation of the Finale After School Program for the afternoon is necessary, we will announce any cancellations in conjunction with the school and communicate through Kid Kiosk via email and/or text message.

Medical Emergencies

All our staff is First Aid/CPR certified and will follow appropriate protocol according to Kidventure and the First Aid/CPR certifications. Parents will be notified by phone immediately of major medical incidents. Minor injuries and incidents will be communicated to parents either by phone or upon pick up. Please ensure contact information is up to date with Kidventure.

Texas Department of Family and Protective Services

Parents are welcome to review a copy of 'Minimum Standards for School Age and Before or After School Programs' from the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services. This outlines all minimum standards that all licensed before and after school programs must follow. A copy is available at the Finale After School Program for parents to review.
